I would be willing to pay an extra few cents per pound of pet food to help provide spay/neuter and save tens of thousands of cats' and dogs' lives each year.

In Washington State over 60,000 homeless cats and dogs are euthanized each year. We need spay/neuter to reduce the number of pets born. The bill proposed for the next legislative session will fund tens of thousands of additional spay/neuter surgeries per year and help us reduce the killing of homeless animals. Funding would come from a fee paid by the initial distributors of pet food (typically pet food manufacturers), not by retailers. Passed directly to purchasers, the fee would cost pet owners less than 3¢ per pound of pet food.

We, the undersigned, are concerned citizens who urge our Washington State legislators to pass companion animal spay/neuter assistance legislation!
