There are several ways you can **Save Washington Pets** and make sure your voice is being heard by policy makers by volunteering with the Washington Alliance for Humane Legislation.

**Advocates are the voice of the animals!** Our volunteer advocates contact their state representatives and senators prior to and during the legislative session via phone calls, emails or by arranging an in-person meeting. Last year over 25 advocates testified during hearings, ensuring that law makers heard from citizens who care about animals and their community. Advocates also use social networking to alert fellow animal lovers when it's time to contact law makers about bills that will help the animals of Washington State. Time commitment during the 60 to 105 days of the session is one-two hours per month.

**Being an outreach superstar is easy!** You've seen them at local events, educating the community about legislation that will make a difference for the animals and encouraging pet lovers to sign the spay/neuter petition. You can sign up to do one event a year or several during a summer. We need outreach volunteers in every corner of the state and at events large and small. Most events have three hour shifts.

**Fundraising for the animals.** We need volunteers with creative writing skills, businesses willing to host small events, and volunteers willing to coordinate fundraising events. Other creative fundraising ideas are welcome! Time commitment is very flexible.

**Website and social networking skills needed.** Help us manage incoming emails via Constant Contact, load up new links, post news and adoption events on our Facebook site, and research options to make our work more effective. A few hours per month will help us reach supporters in time for them to take action.
